# Protecting Our Elders:

## June is Elder Abuse Awareness Month

Unfortunately, financial scams targeting older adults continue to rise nationwide. Fraudsters often attempt to gain people's trust through phone calls, emails, or impersonation scams to access personal financial information.

### Common scams targeting seniors include:

- Impersonation calls claiming to be from government agencies or financial institutions
- Requests for urgent payments or gift cards
- Fraud by caregivers or individuals with financial access
- Misuse of payment apps or online transfers

Warning signs of financial exploitation may include sudden account withdrawals, unusual transactions, or pressure to send money quickly.

If something doesn't feel right, contact the credit union immediately. Reporting suspicious activity early can help protect your account and prevent further loss.

# Important Account Information

## Keep Your Account Active and Up to Date

Spring is a great time to review your account information and make sure everything is up to date.

**Tax Season Reminder** - The federal tax filing deadline is April 15. Using your eStatements and Tax Documents can make tax preparation easier by giving you quick, secure access to your account statements whenever you need them.

**Update Your Information** - If you've recently moved or experienced a life change, be sure to update your address, phone number, email, and beneficiary information with the credit union.

**Dormant Account Reminder** - Accounts with no activity for 12 months may become dormant, and a monthly dormancy fee may apply beginning in month 13.

**Inactive Accounts** - Accounts that remain inactive for three years may be subject to escheatment, meaning the funds must be transferred to the state as required by state law. The good news is that keeping your account active is simple — just make at least one transaction each year.
